HISTORY

The Lokve company was established back in 1952, initially focusing on wood processing with a cutting-edge sawmill. The construction of new facilities and the formation of the first production line in 1973 marked the beginning of wooden window production.

Since 1994, the company has been fully family-owned, involving three generations. Lokve emerged as a market leader, pioneering the introduction of wood-aluminum windows and the first windows for low-energy and passive construction in the Croatian market.

Today, Lokve has over 120 employees and is the leading manufacturer of wooden and wood-aluminum windows in Croatia. Our production facilities, spanning over 15,000 m² of covered area in the heart of Gorski Kotar's forests, extend across more than 70,000 m² of land.



FROM TIMBER PROCESSING TO FINAL PRODUCT

Directly sourced from the surrounding forests of Gorski Kotar, we transport fresh logs to our primary processing sawmill. The wood then undergoes drying in our kilns before final processing into finished products, utilizing state-of-the-art CNC machines with CAD/CAM technology. Our computer-controlled system plans and monitors production through every stage.

Accompanying our modern machining equipment is a high-capacity automated robotic painting facility, with painting capacity of over 15,000 windows annually.

The significant advantage of such a comprehensive process lies in our ability to control input materials and ensure the highest quality of our final products.

Here at Lokve, we continuously strive to develop and enhance all manufacturing processes and products, as evidenced by our ISO 9001 quality management system certification. We take pride in holding an FSC certification, ensuring that the wood used in our products originates from responsibly managed forests.



SUSTAINABLE WINDOW PRODUCTION WITH SOLAR ENERGY

A large solar power system with a capacity of 625 kW spread across 4000 m² of roof space on our production halls, comprising over 1900 panels, harnesses energy. It generates 50% of the total required electrical energy for window production. Through solar energy, we significantly reduce CO₂ emissions, elevate our environmental consciousness, and contribute to nature preservation.

Furthermore, Lokve implements sustainability strategy by installing a 4 MW boiler heating system. The produced heat serves to warm the production facilities and kilns and the fuel required is entirely sourced from wood residue from the timber cutting process.



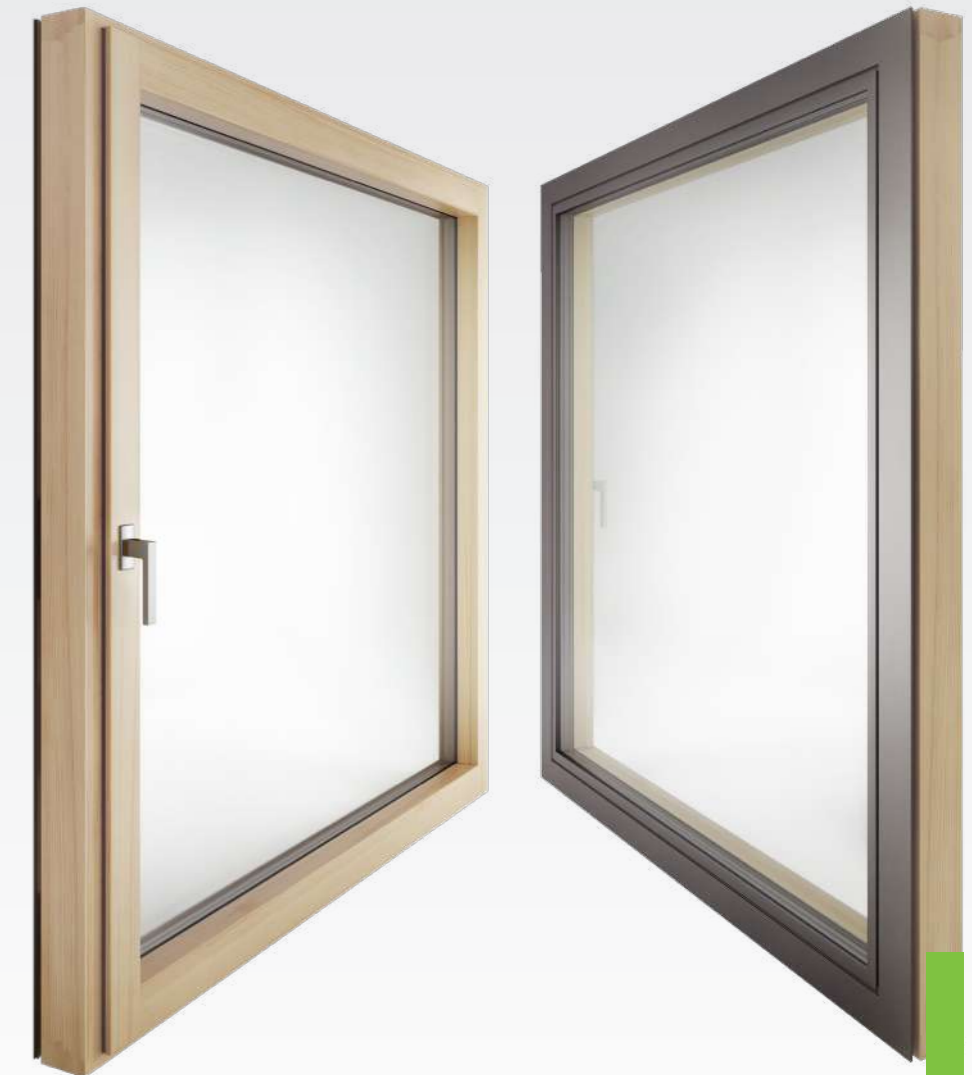
WOOD AND WOOD ALUMINIUM WINDOWS

The exceptional flexibility of wood as a material allows window production in any shape, size, or color. Wood-aluminum windows today represent windows of the highest quality and design. The perfect combination of wood on the inside, creating a cozy and warm interior, and aluminum on the outside, providing durability and modernity.

Lokve windows are equipped with high-quality fittings from the German manufacturer Roto GmbH and premium glass from the Austrian manufacturer Uniglas. The high level of quality of our products is also guaranteed by German certifications from the accredited institute IFT Rosenheim.

Our windows are tested and certified for air permeability, water tightness, wind load resistance, burglary resistance, and thermal conductivity.

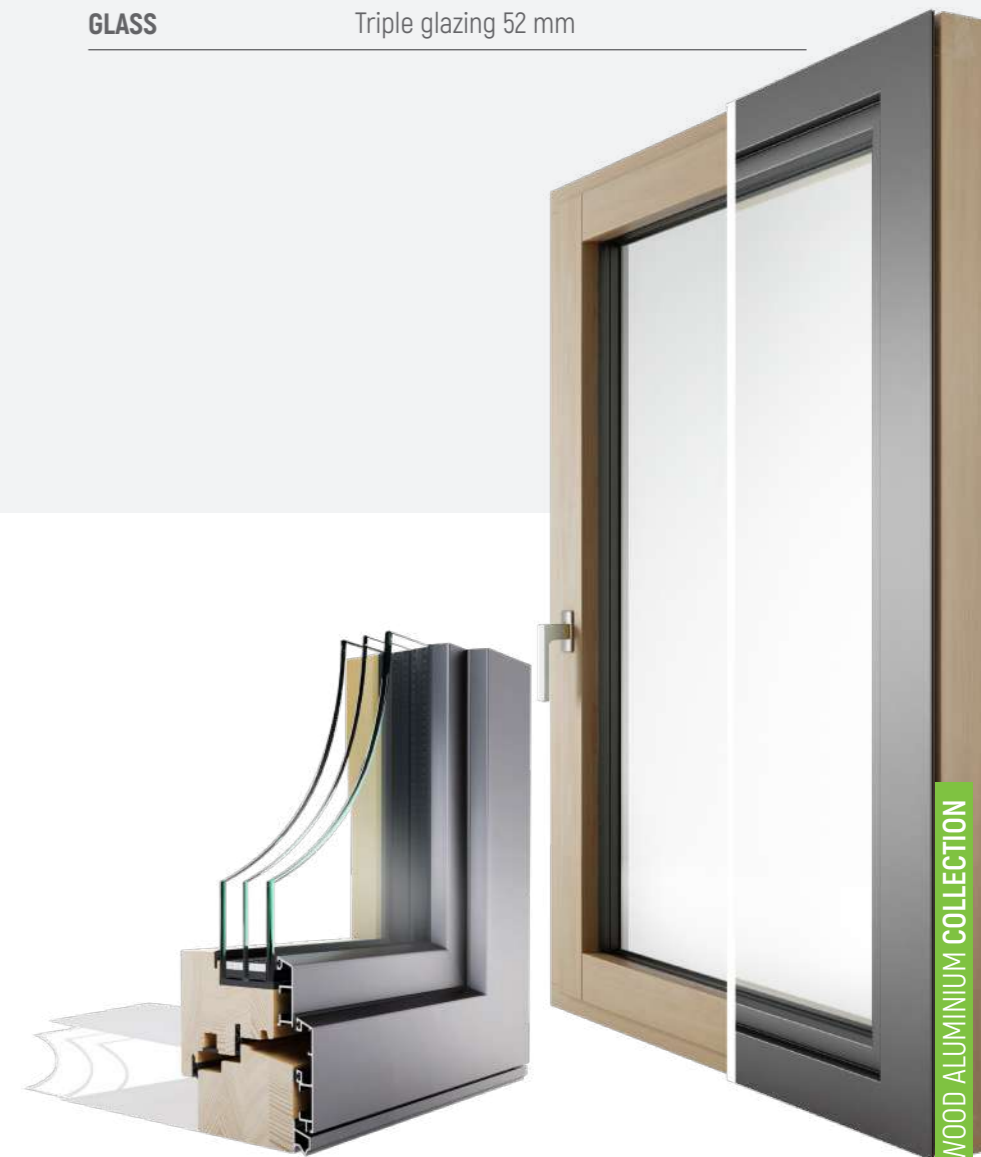

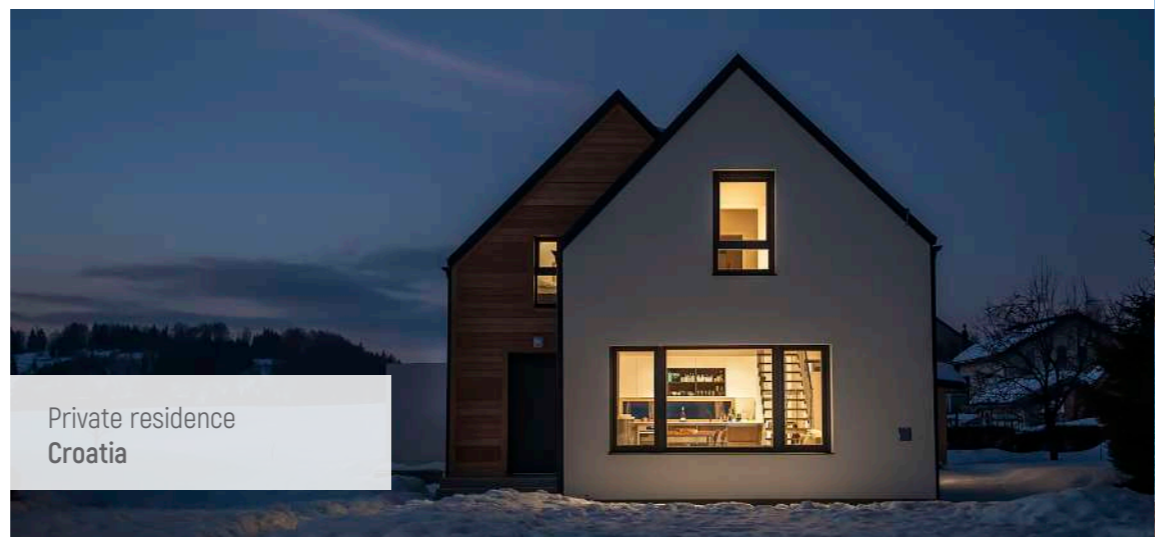

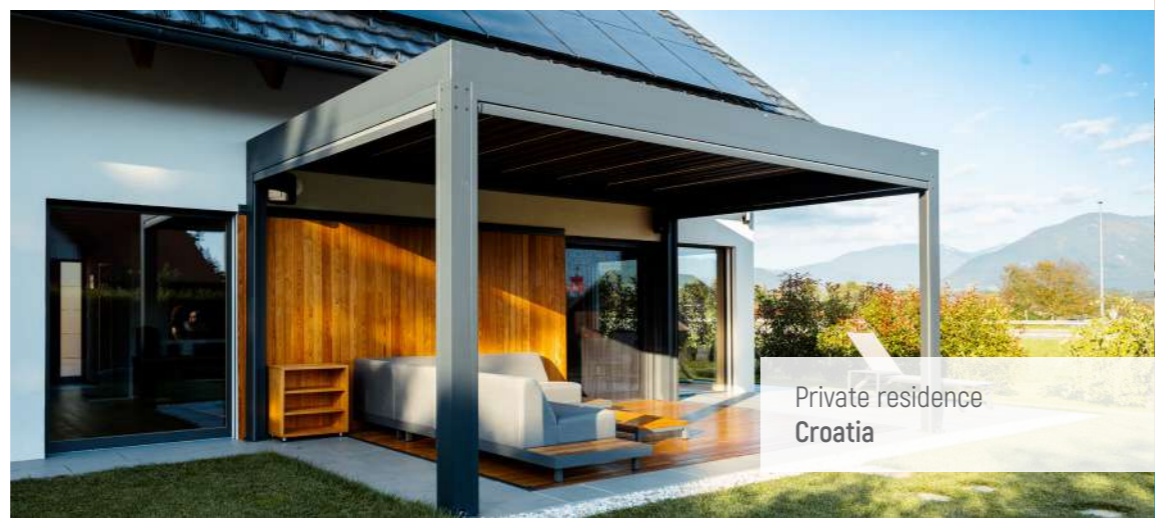
